Performance Techniques:

A method that makes a performance better allowing the actor to give more information to the audience about a character's situation

Still Image:		Freeze Frame:	
	A frozen picture that tells the audience what is happening without action.		This freeze take place in the middle of a scene. This pauses the action before it continues.
Devil & Angel:		Conscience Alley:	
	The Angel represents the conscience, and the Devil represents temptation. The person in a dilemma must listen to both sides and to help decide		A character with a dilemma listens to their conscience who share the good and bad points of a decision that needs to be made.
Thought Track		Narration:	
	A character steps out of the scene/ freeze frame and delivers their thoughts to the audience.		An actor tells part of the story to the audience at the front of the stage. This is done in third person (He/She/ They/ Them/ Name)
